REOPENING OF SCHOOL

Hurray!! Airmyn Park Primary School looks forward to welcoming you back on site!!

Following the advice and guidance published on Monday it's wonderful to be able to say welcome again to fully coming back to school. As the situation is still at the beginnings of, hopefully, coming out of the long-term lockdown, the school arrangements and systems of infection control will remain as they were in the Autumn Term. I will review this at Easter based on the Government Guidance.

Beginning on Monday March 8th hot school meals will be provided again from Kingsway and the Breakfast and After School Club will reopen. (booking details to follow).

All children will have their temperature taken at the start of the school day and I ask that any new emergency contact details are given to the school office in case we need to contact you. Staff will continue to wear face masks in school.

Unfortunately, parents and carers are not permitted to enter the school building unless prior arrangements have been made. If you need to speak to a member of staff in person please come to the Reception door at the front of the school where the office staff will be happy to assist.

Children do not need to bring book bags, PE bags or any other items into school, except for water bottles and packed lunch boxes if appropriate. Hand sanitizer does not need to be brought into school as there is plenty available for the children to use. Your child needs to attend in school uniform as normal.

The school arrangements for arriving and leaving school are below following the same staggered order as in the Autumn Term;

Class 4

8.30 am entering in the playground door3.00 pm Collection from the playground

Class 3

8.45 am entering in the playground door 3.15 pm Collection from the playground

Class 1 and Class 2

9.00am Class 2 entering in the front entrance door and Class 1 entering from the playground 3.30pm Collection from the playground

















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Children in a family arrive with the eldest child and leave with the youngest.

For example, if you have children in Year 5 and Year 1, they will both attend at

school at 8.30am and leave at 3.30pm. Children will stay in their respective

classrooms whilst waiting for collection. Children in Class 2 will still enter school through the main Reception door, and all other children will enter from the playground as in the Autumn term. All children will be collected from the playground at the end of their school day. Please arrive as near to collection time as possible continue to stand socially distanced on the school playground. The School Streets regulations around school continue as statutory.

Appropriate arrangements for safe lunchtimes have been made and your child will still have the option of choosing a hot meal or a packed lunch each day. Arrangements for Toast and Juice and the School Tuck Shop on Fridays are being considered.

On the day that your child will be having a PE lesson they should come to school in their PE kit, including joggers and a hoodie just as they have been doing. The PE timetable will be posted on See Saw and Tapestry.

Volunteers in school will resume in the Summer Term hopefully. Unfortunately, all educational visits are advised against and are under government review; however, I will write to you again very soon to share with you some exciting planned events taking place within school.

In the event of a COVID19 positive result all previous procedures continue, the school office must be informed and self-isolating rules apply unchanged. Teachers will provide Learning Grids on See Saw and Tapestry should classes/bubbles need to close.

Further details regarding the many areas we are looking at including the reintroduction of school reading books, assessment and the school recovery curriculum will be shared with you in due course.

Thank you for your amazing continued support, we will work together through this next stage. Please do not hesitate to contact myself, teachers or the school office with any queries or concerns. your children and tell them that all of us in school are really looking forward to seeing them again in person very soon!
