Sports Day – Friday 1st July

We are looking forward to holding our sports day events in school next week. Parents are invited to school from 1.15pm, via the gates in the school carpark. The gates will be closed before the event to allow the children to be safe in school. Refreshments are available to purchase through the Friends and Family pop up shop. The events will start at 1.30pm and the children will compete in their house teams. Please send the children to school in their PE kit on this day. We will endeavour to keep the children in the shade as much as possible, however, please send them to school with a water bottle, sun hat and long-lasting sun cream applied. On this occasion we will allow children to bring in additional sun cream to top up after lunch. Please ensure this is named!

Music Lessons

We are delighted to be able to continue to offer guitar and percussion lessons from September. There are limited places if anyone else would like to take up these instruments. Music lessons are charged to parents on a termly basis. We calculate the cost of lessons based on the uptake. This is to enable us to provide you with the most reasonable price, without a negative impact on the budget. We are also hoping to be able to provide piano lessons from September. Please contact the school office if you would like your child to play the piano. We would usually recommend from Year 2 upwards, but will consider younger children if requested.

Family Fun Afternoon

Our family fun afternoon will take place on Thursday 7th July from 3pm and you are invited to school from 3.20pm. Families are welcome to bring a picnic to enjoy on the school field and children in Class 4 have created some games for everyone's enjoyment. We will also have refreshments available. To aid with organisation, all children are welcome to come to school in non-uniform on Thursday 7th July in return for a donation of a tombola prize or baked goods for our cake sale.

The School Day

Thank you to everyone for the smooth change for the timings for the school day, which has shown that the children are all ready to work much quicker making our mornings much more productive. As a reminder, the new timings for the day are 8.50am–3.20pm. The doors open each



morning from 8.45am to allow the children to be in the classrooms and ready for the register at 8.50am. In the afternoon the gate will be opened at 3.15pm to allow adults into the playground ready to collect the children at 3.20pm.


