

## Maths

### Year 3

Place value- numbers up to 1,000 represented in various forms. Addition and subtraction- across 10 and 100 and with 3-digit numbers. Multiplication and division- 3-, 4- and 8-times tables.

### Year 4:

Place value- numbers up to 10,000 represented in various forms. Addition and subtraction- up to 4-digit numbers with and without exchange. Area. Multiplication and division- learning all times tables up to 12x12

## English

This half term the children will focus on building suspense in their writing. Alongside reading texts, the children will write their own fear tale about a scary place. In our non-fiction writing, the children will be creating non-chronological reports about scary, magical creatures.

Throughout the first half term the children will review their knowledge and understanding of capital letter and punctuation marks. They will also identify different word classes and what 'makes a sentence'.
