Year 3

Multiply and divide 2 digits by 1-digit numbers, cm/ mm, equivalent lengths, comparing lengths, adding and subtracting lengths, perimeter.

Year 4:

Factors, multiply and divide by 10/100, multiply 2- and 3-digit numbers, perimeter of shapes, understanding wholes and parts, mixed numbers.
